The device has been set-up so that it will be easy to use. It is pre-loaded with a selection of e-books for you to choose from. There's nothing more that you need to do! Just choose a book and start reading!

RESTRICTIONS

Please do not register or unregister the device or alter any of its settings.

Due to some technological and logistical limitations, borrowers are not permitted to purchase, subscribe to, or download e-books, apps, or other items to the device.

E-Readers are compatible with e-books that can be borrowed from the Jones Library through our Digital Catalog. We are very happy to demonstrate the process of borrowing an e-book at the Reference Desk. However, you are not permitted to borrow an e-book using the device.

Please do not connect the device to your personal computer or attempt to sync it to Adobe Digital Editions or any other software.

Please do not let anyone else borrow the device or allow children to play with the device without adult supervision. Please be cautious with the device so that it is not dropped or damaged by water. Please keep the device clean, and use only a clean lint-free cloth to clean it.

Lastly, please return the device and all its accessories to the Jones Library Reference Desk as described in the Borrower Agreement.

The accessories are: 1 USB cable, 1 AC power adapter, 1 protective cover, and 1 carrying case. (The NOOKs also include 1 Quick Start Guide.)

Please note that any missing or damaged accessories may result in replacement charges.
