Signature Solicitation Guidelines

By law, ballot-access and nomination paper signature solicitation is allowed in the Library, subject to the following time, place and manner regulations:

- The solicitor must check-in at the Library's Adult Circulation Desk;
- Solicitations in the Jones Library will either take place in the Community Room or outside; solicitations in the North Amherst or Munson Memorial Libraries will take place either indoors or outside;
- Persons circulating petitions or handouts are not allowed to place or erect tables, chairs or signs on Library property;
- The solicitor will not block, hinder, interfere or otherwise impede patrons and staff in the use of the Library, nor intimidate patrons into signing a petition or accepting a handout;
- Nomination papers and political petitions may not be left unattended;
- Only one solicitor per issue is allowed;
- The Library Trustees, Friends, and staff are exempt from the above constraints in promoting Library activities and issues.
