

Library eBooks & eAudiobooks for Kindle Fire Tablets

BEST OPTIONS *

- 1 Download and read an EPUB eBook (requires the free OverDrive app)
- 2 Download and listen to an MP3 eAudiobook (requires the free OverDrive app)

* Other options include: Read an eBook in your browser (no app needed, but portability is limited as it requires a continuous wireless internet connection) and Download and read a Kindle Book (no app needed, but unable to play audiobooks).

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1 Download and read an EPUB eBook

- Tap **Apps** on your Kindle Fire menu
- Search the **Store** for the free OverDrive app and install it
- Open the app, tap **Sign Up**, then tap **Sign up using library card**
- To Find your library, tap the **Location** button, then enter your zip code and tap **Go**
- Tap on the name of your library to select it
- Enter your library card number, and select **Sign In**
- Answer the question “Are you 13 or older?” and then tap **Sign up**
- Tap **Add a title** to visit the OverDrive Digital Catalog
- Tap **Sign In**, enter your library card number again, and tap **Sign In**
- Find an eBook that interests you
 - Search by title, author, or keyword via the search box at the top – or tap the 3 horizontal bars on the right to browse by Subject or Collection (for example, select **Mystery** under the Subject menu)
 - Select the book cover to see a description of the book or to view a sample, if available
 - To display only eBooks available right now, tap **Filters**, then **Available now** (under Availability)
- Select **Borrow**
- Select **Go to Loans**
- Tap **Download** and select **EPUB eBook**



- Your eBook will download automatically within the app; tap the 3 horizontal bars at the top left, select **Bookshelf**, and tap the cover to start reading

② Download and listen to an MP3 eAudiobook

- See Option 1 (above) but choose MP3 Audiobooks instead of EPUB eBooks when applicable
